

## Preparing for a Cystic Fibrosis Clinic Appointment

It's a good idea to plan for your CF clinic appointment and make the most out of your visit. Start thinking about what you'd like to learn or share before the actual day. These simple tips can help you organize your thoughts ahead of time and make it easier to cover important health or wellness topics with your care team.

رگا	MAKE A LIST & PRIORITIZE YOUR CONCERNS		
<b>✓</b>	<ul> <li>Don't put off topics that are on your mind until the end of your appointment - bring them up right away</li> <li>What are the top 3 concerns you want to address at your next visit?</li> <li>Do you have a new symptom?</li> <li>Are there changes in your health?</li> <li>Are you concerned about how a treatment is affecting your daily life?</li> <li>Have you had a major life event?</li> <li>Has your insurance changed since your last appointment?</li> </ul>		
~	KEEP THE CARE TEAM UP TO DATE WITH NEW INFORMATION		
	<ul> <li>Let the care team know what has happened in your life since your last visit.</li> <li>Have you experienced a major medical event such as, being hospitalized or treated in the emergency room?</li> <li>Are you seeing a new doctor or a specialist?</li> <li>Mention any changes you have noticed in your appetite, weight, sleep or energy level.</li> <li>Discuss recent changes in any medications you take or the effects they have had on you.</li> </ul>		
	PRESCRIPTIONS & MEDICATIONS		
	<ul> <li>□ Bring a list of your prescriptions.</li> <li>□ Do you carry a list of your medications with you in case of emergency?</li> <li>□ Do you know how to store medications properly?</li> <li>□ Do you review medication expiration dates?</li> <li>□ Are you able to access prescribed medications?</li> <li>□ Do you need medication refills?</li> <li>□ Are you taking any over-the-counter medicines?</li> <li>□ Do you take vitamins, herbal remedies or supplements?</li> <li>□ Have you experienced side effects?</li> <li>□ Have there been any drug interactions?</li> <li>□ Review the order of your treatments</li> </ul>
